CHILDREN'S MINISTRY

Take-home Scriptures and activities

Age 3-4

Acts 16: 16-34 Today we learned that we worship God by thanking Him. Make a list of all the things you should thank God for and why those things are important. Then say a prayer together specifically listing those things. Add new items to the list during the week.

Pre-K and K

Acts 27:13-44 Today we learned that God wants us to share the good news about Jesus. Have each member of the family draw a picture or make a collage of the way that God is working in your lives.

Grades 1-2

2 Chronicles 5:1-14 Today we learned that God is with us when we worship. Say a prayer praising God for being such a great God. Then take a walk around the neighborhood and look for evidence of God. It could be kindness - neighbors talking with each other, it could be beautiful things in nature that remind you of God's creation. Sturdy homes could remind us that God protects us. If there is a breeze, look at the leaves. The wind – which you cannot see – is like God – we can't see Him, but He is always here with us.

Grades 3-4

Acts 27: 9-44 Today we learned that God takes care of those who follow him. Also read 1 Peter 5:7 . On a piece of paper, write down the things that cause you to worry or be afraid. Put it in an envelope and stick it in your Bible. Wait a few weeks, and take the list out. Write down what God did with those worries.

Grade 5

Philippians 1:3-6 Today we learned that God's people can be joyful and positive. This week as a family, either at dinner or some other time you are all together, take turns answering questions like:

I want to be able to...

The most powerful person I know is...

I could be a better friend (son, daughter, spouse) if I ...
